

MESSAGE FROM FR. QUENTIN

Next Tuesday is the Feast day of Saint Pope John Paul II. Many of us have lived during his pontificate. Pope John Paul II was always known to be a great teacher of the faith. One of the great teachings he gave us is the Theology of the Body. He gave the teachings to us during his Papal audiences. I have learned that there was a book

behind his "Theology of the Body" that he wrote before he was Pope as Cardinal Karol Wojtyla. The book is "Love and Responsibility." Last week our youth had a presentation given by the Culture Project. In the presentation the presenters focused on human "Love dignity. Responsibility" Cardinal Wojtyla connects our call to love to the value and dignity of a person.



the human person. This determines the value of the person. A person must not be put on the same level as a thing (or for that matter as an individual animal): the person possesses spiritual perfectibility, and is by way of being an (embodied) spirit, not merely a 'body' magnificently endowed with life."

> The Culture Project gave this exact teaching from the saint we celebrate. We are not a thing to be objectified but a person to be loved. This is exactly the teaching of Saint John Paul II as he continued in his book to describe the call to love. At the foundation of a call to love is the dignity and value of a person.

"The commandment to love, as has been said, a form of the personalistic norm. We start from the existence of the person, and go to acknowledge the peculiar value of the person. The world of existence is the world of objects: amongst them we distinguish between persons and things. A person differs from a thing in structure and in degree of perfection. To the structure of the person belongs an 'interior,' in which we find the elements of spiritual life, and it is this that compels us to acknowledge the spiritual nature of the human soul, and the peculiar perfectibility of "Love in the full sense of the word is a virtue, not just an emotion, and still less a mere excitement of the senses. This virtue is produced in the will and has at its disposal the resources of the will's spiritual potential: in other words, it is an authentic commitment of the free will of the one person (the subject), resulting from the truth about another person (the object). Love as a virtue is oriented by the will towards the value of the person. The will, then, is the source of that affirmation of the person which permeates all the reactions, all the feelings, the whole behavior of the subject."
