

THE FATHERS LOVE

The reading we get this Sunday from the Gospel of Luke is often described as the parable of the Prodigal Son. Another way to describe it would be to call it the parable of the Loving Father. By using this description it allows us to focus in on the love of God the Father has for all of us.

The love of the Father stays consistent in the parable. In the beginning, he freely gives to the son who requested the inheritance. After that son squanders all he has been given and comes back in humility the Father again showers down his love upon him. "While he was still a long way off, his father caught sight of him, and was filled with compassion. He ran to his son, embraced him and kissed him....His father ordered his servants, 'Quickly bring the finest robe and put it on him; put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. Take the fattened calf and slaughter it. Then let us celebrate with a feast, because this son of mine was dead, and has come to life again; he was lost, and has been found.""

When the other son in the parable begins to be upset with the love of the Father for this returning son the Father lets him also know of the deep love he has always had for him as well. "He said to him, 'My son, you are here with me always; everything I have is yours."" The Lord uses expressions like property, possessions, hired workers, fattened calf that could make us think of things. Ultimately this is a reminder that what God most desires for us is to experience a share of His Blessed Life and to be His beloved children resting in his presence.
